Questions and prompts. Let's talk about:

RELATIONSHIPS

-How do Jasper's relationships with his dad, his friend Clarence, and Maya change over the course of the story? How might they change again going forward? -How would Jasper and Maya's relationship be different if their genders were reversed? -Have any of your relationships to family or friends changed over time? How and why?

TIME

-What is time?

-Would you want to be a time bender? Even if you were the only one in your family? How about the only one on earth?

-How does time perception differ in your life? Think about boring vs. exciting times, happy vs. sad, yesterday vs. years ago. How does the mind play tricks on us and why?

STORY STRUCTURE

-All heroic narratives share a number of story elements. What are some similarities between *Jasper Faulks* and other books or movies you know that follow a hero's journey? How about differences?

-What did Jasper, Maya, and Eva want at the beginning of their journeys and what did they get at the end? Are they better off or worse? -If you think of your own life as a hero's journey, what do you want and what stands in your way? How could you achieve your goal?

SUPERPOWERS

-What are the limits of Jasper's powers? Without cheating, could he beat Usain Bolt in a sprint? World Champion Magnus Carlsen at chess? Heavyweight Champion Tyson Fury in boxing? What Olympic sports would he dominate and where would he fail?

-Do you think Jasper should use his powers in public and become a superhero? How could he and other time benders change the world for the better?

-How would you spend your time as a time bender?

INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

-How did information technology change the life of the time benders? -Imagine your life without modern information technology. What would be better?



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
